This approach was developed originally by the settlement house movement. The objective needs assessment was mainly based on health status and only covered the ability of older persons to maintain daily living by themselves and could not substitute for a subjective assessment of need from the perspective of the older person. Most older people can carry out daily functions without assistance, but over half could not do more complex instrumental activities without help.
